Change of Classrooms

Echo Academy now offers 2 multiage classrooms. There are 8 children in each multiage class. Teacher Siriya is a primary teacher for Multiage Red class while Teacher Amy and Teacher Brianna are the main teachers for the Yellow class. A multiage group is an enriching learning environment. This class is constructed based on the inquiry-based approach. This means it is a child-centered environment that focuses on both developmentally and individually appropriate practice. In this classroom, your child will have more time to "blossom," without "performance" pressure. Due to our smaller class size, your child will develop a sense of family with their peers. They will become a family of learners who lead, follow, support, and care for each other.

Learning Focus

<u>Multiage Red</u> will continue working on phonics and handwriting. We do math every Thursday and Friday. We have been working on number sense. Our children learn to print and recognize numbers and quantity. We will also talk about the rain, clouds, storms, and thunder.

<u>Multiage Yellow's</u> main focus is peer-to-peer support. Older children in this class will work on teaching and guiding their younger friends. Older children will gain a sense of competence while our younger ones will learn how to work with others.

<u>3-5 (Green)</u> are focusing on spring and St. Patrick's Day. Preschool has always been at the heart of learning for this class. Children will continue working on printing their names and tracing letters.
